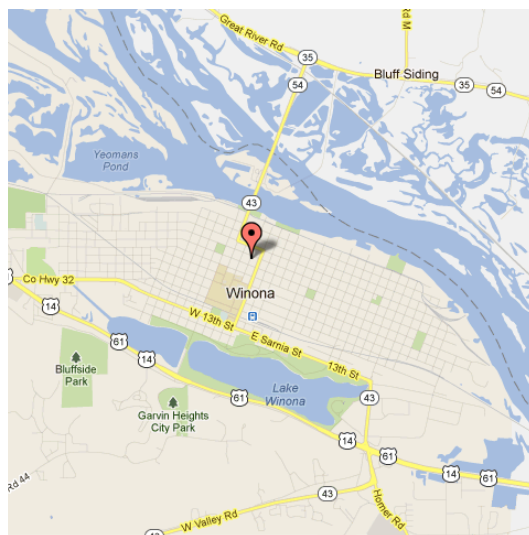
DIRECTIONS

From Interstate 90 - Take Exit 252 and take Hwy 43 North to Winona. At Hwy 61 intersection take a left and proceed north on Hwy 61. At Huff St intersection take a right and follow Huff St. until the Broadway/6th St intersection. Take a right on Broadway and go 3 blocks and church will be on your left but parking is on the right in lots.

From Hwy 61 traveling south - Take a left at the Huff St intersection stop light. Proceed until the Broadway/6th St intersection. Take a right on Broadway and go 3 blocks and church will be on your left but parking is on the right in lots.

From Hwy 61 traveling north- Take a right at the Huff St intersection stop light. Proceed until the Broadway/6th St. intersection. Take a right on Broadway and go 3 blocks and church will be on your left but parking is on the right in lots
